
## THE PROJECT

The **Ministry of Transportation (MTO)** continues to move forward with new Highway 7 from Kitchener to Guelph following a three phased approach.

**MTO** has awarded an Advanced Clearing and Grading contract to **Kiewit Canada Group** to commence pre-construction works for new Highway 7 Grand River Bridges (Phase 2).

These works are scheduled to begin in fall 2025 and include vegetation clearing, right-of-way fence installation, and advance grading to support geotechnical investigations that will inform the design for the future construction of the new Highway 7 Grand River Bridges. Timing for the construction of the bridges, when available, will be included on the <a href="https://www.NewHighway7.ca">www.NewHighway7.ca</a> website.
